The German national federation of Flying Disc

- The German Frisbee Sports Association was founded in 1990.
- Currently 10 regional Frisbee associations, three more in the process of being founded
- Aims for application for admission to DOSB by the end of 2023
- Around 190 member associations in all federal states nationwide
- 8,500+ registered athletes
- more than 10% growth annually
- -The DFV represents
- the team sport Ultimate (65%)
- the individual sport of disc golf (34%)
- artistic freestyle frisbee (1%)
- and so-called "field events"
- German Championships since 1981

World association WFDF is recognized by the IOC

World Flying Disc Federation, WFDF

- has more than 100 national member associations
- Member of ARISF, GAISF, FISU, cooperation with WADA and TAFISA
- Ultimate at World Games since 2001, application as an additional Olympic discipline
- Freestyle Frisbee at first World Urban Games 2019 in Budapest
- Ultimate was foreseen for World Master Games 2021 in Kansai
- 1st Ultimate School World Championship 2019 in Le Mans
- DFV has been cooperating with NADA since 2016 (testing since 2017)
- Since April 2015, the TU Darmstadt with its Institute for Sports Science is official federal competitive sports base of the DFV.
- Most of the national team training courses and trainer training courses take place there.
- Participation WG 2022




Sport of Ultimate Frisbee

- Ultimate is the world's most popular flying disc sport
- estimated 8 million practitioners
- World Games 2013/2017:
- best visited, most clicked
- 2013: "Ambassador Discipline of Fair Play"
- Germany participated in WG 2022
- Mixed Gender Sport (Germany was Beach Ultimate World Champion 2015, won Bronze 2017)
- Fair play conception
- appeals to youth
- media friendly (olympic channel)

Individual sports for everyone

- Challenge for recreational and competitive players
- easy entry (driver, approach & putter disc)
- for young and old
- either for popular sports in existing facilities
- or as a top sport (technology and concentration)
- German top athlete Simon Lizotte:
 World Championship bronze,
 two-time European champion
- Team D Vice World Champion at Team World Championship 2019
- approx. ½ million active disc golfers worldwide
- big growth



Sport of Freestyle Frisbee



Gymnastic-dance free program

- Playful introduction
- easy and difficult basic elements: trick catches, "body roll", "nail delay"
- Jury evaluation according to 3 categories (difficulty, execution, artistic impression)
- highly attractive to watch
- very strong top German athletes (several European and World Championship titles and in the top ten in the world)
- Participation in the first edition of the World Urban Games 2019 Budapest



More Disc Sports





Overall programme with seven disciplines

- Self-Caught Flights (Throw, Run, and Catch)
- Accuracy (see pictures, 4 throws each from 7 positions)
- Distance (the world record is over 300 m)
- Discathon (running through a course with 2 discs, from throw to throw)
- Double disc court (back pass game with 2 discs on two fields at the same time)
- Overall: above 5 plus freestyle and disc golf

In addition:

 Guts (5 against 5 throw at each other at a distance of 14 meters, while catching is only allowed with 1 hand)





Goals



Popularization of Frisbee sports

- Youth promotion
 - plus training curriculum (mainly trainer level 1 with 120 teaching units)
 - School brochure Ultimate (instructions for secondary schools)
 - Emphasizing personal responsibility (ability to deal with conflict, solution methods)
 - Spirit of the Game workshops
- Strengthening of the national associations
 - targeted local approach
 - Regionalization (short distances)
 - Expansion of game operations





Practice respectful behavior

- Ultimate Official Rules, Introduction: "Ultimate has no external judges and is non-contact. The spirit of the game dictates how players govern the game themselves and behave on the field."
- Players must report and resolve fouls and violations of the rules themselves
- Both perspectives are considered before decisions are made
- When in doubt, attack keeps the disc (back to previous thrower)

 - eye-hand coordination, throwing technique, sprinting ability resp. endurance, ability to concentrate, strong mental component




- Recognition of the training according to the DOSB licensing system




DFV Members, each at the beginning of the year
